Let me give you a picture ...Tony Paopao is Samoan. He is 6'5" tall and weighs 385lbs. Intimidating is a word that comes to my mind. But Tony is also the father of 3-year-old Willow, who he has been taking to ballet classes every Saturday for months. And, of course, all the practices lead up to the big recital – Willow's first dance recital. For Willow's age group, a parent was required to accompany the child on stage. Since Tony had been at all of Willow's practices and he was familiar with the dance routine, it made sense for him to be that parent. There was just one problem, the dance class instructor "strongly suggested" that Mr. Paopao wear a tutu. Two concerns stood out for him: 1) He was already a big man and he didn't want to bring anymore attention to himself, and 2) He didn't want to confuse his daughter as to why he was wearing a tutu.

After encouragement from his wife AND his daughter, Tony finally agreed to accompany his daughter on stage wearing a tutu. Dressed in black with a black tutu, Tony danced with Willow spinning her around and picking her up and down complemented by Willow's constant smiles and giggles.

Mr. Paopao was right. He did stand out, but not for the reasons he thought. What people noticed (those at the recital and the thousands who have since watched the video) was a father whose love for his daughter superseded what people might think about him. In the end, people saw how unselfish the love of this father really is.

Isn't that the very heart of Christianity? We love others unselfishly, because our Father in heaven so loved us!
